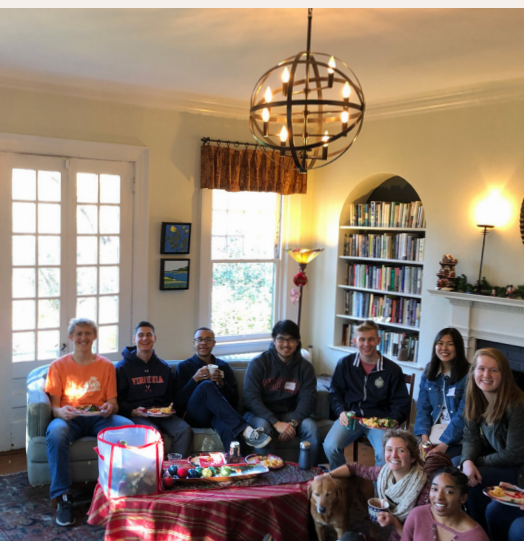

BONHOEFFER HOUSE

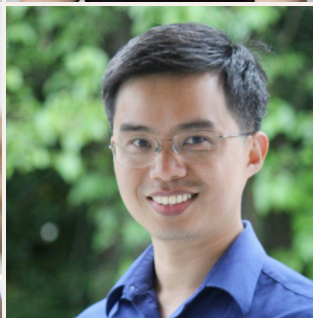
